

Grant guide: Ways to Qualify

The Government's Energy Company Obligation grant scheme has £4 billion of grant funding available for UK households.

The current phase called ECO4 targets inefficient properties. The grants are very generous for the properties that qualify.

Grants also available under the new Great British Insulation Scheme (previously called ECO+).

HOUSEHOLD ELIGIBILITY

Households can qualify for grants in a range of ways.

1. Receiving Benefits (Direct)

 ${}$ ${}$ The following qualifying benefits are included:

- Child Tax Credit
- Employment & Support Allowance (Income Based)
- Income Support
- Housing Benefit
- Jobseekers Allowance (Income Based)
- Pension Credit Guarantee Credit
- Pension Credit Savings Credit
- Universal Credit
- Working Tax Credit

You don't need to be currently claiming providing the benefit was claimed in the 12 months prior to the installation. There are no income requirements.

2. Claiming Child Benefit (Direct)

✓ Your annual household income must not exceed the following limits:

	Single Parents	Couples
1 Child	£19,900	£27,500
2 Children	£24,800	£32,300
3 Children	£29,600	£37,200
4+ Children	£34,500	£42,000

Evidence will need to be provided to confirm eligibility.

3. Income-based Eligibility (Flex)

✓ Your annual household income will need to be under £31,000

Evidence will need to be provided to confirm eligibility.

Properties need to have an Energy Performance Certificate rating of D, E, F or G to qualify.

4. Being vulnerable (Flex)

- Vulnerable people can access grants if they meet two of the following criteria (1 & 3 can't be used together):
 - Lives in a Lower Super Output Area
 Receives Council Tax Rebate (excluding for single person discounts)
 - 3. Householder meets NICE guidelines for being vulnerable including having a disability, mental health condition, being over 65, children under 5 and pregnant women.

4. Receives free school meals due to a low income

5. Supported by a Council scheme described in a Statement of Intent

6. Households referred by a Citizen's advice as struggling to pay gas and electricity bills7. Households in energy debt

A medical practitioner will need to <u>complete a</u> <u>referral form</u> to confirm eligibility.

5. Health Eligibility (Flex)

- People with health conditions that are made worse by living in a cold home qualify. These include:
 - Cardiovascular diseases
 - Immunosuppressed
 - Mobility issues
 - Respiratory conditions

A medical practitioner will need to <u>complete a</u> <u>referral form</u> to confirm eligibility.

6. Bespoke targeting
